# Ways & Means Coordinators—Kathy H & Ruthanne A

When we took over the position of W & M coordinators last fall, there were approximately 350 "Think"Pen/highlighters left from the 1210 fundraiser. About 75-100 of those have been sold at the price of \$2 or 2 for \$3.50 since the last Assembly Meeting.

We propose that the remainder be sold at \$1.00 each.

In February, Kathy took the pens and fundraiser trinkets to the Al-Anon Serenity Day and sold quite a few of the coins, tie tacks and bracelets but only a few pens.

For the next fundraiser, we have investigated tote bags at two different suppliers. The first (Branders) can sell us 500 bags at 78 cents apiece, if we provide the artwork. Total cost (including shipping) would be \$503. The second (4AllPromos) can sell us 500 bags at 95 cents apiece and will provide the artwork. The total cost would be about \$570.

We decided to use the word 'Serenity" with a butterfly above the "I", with the design in lime green on a royal blue tote. Cindy P. has a friend who can do the artwork for us in the format needed.

We propose to order 500 bags from Branders and have them available for the nest Assembly Meeting, to be sold at \$2.00 each. Today's Ways and Means raffle will be a few items that were donated by members. For the July Assembly Meeting raffle, we are asking everyone to bring baked goods.

## Group Records Secretary—Mary S

Group Records at WSO has modernized the method of updating information. As of Jan. 2011 the Area Group Records Secretary has the ability to change the records at WSO. I'm blessed to have begun this position of SIAFG Group Records Coordinator at this time. Please note the

group records form on the WSO members' website still has the instructions to send forms to WSO. If sent to WSO they will change records but they must wait for volunteers to complete this task and the volume of changes is worldwide. The form is then sent to the SIAFG Group Records Coordinator.

In order for Southern IL groups to take advantage of this FASTER method, group changes need to be SENT TO THE **SIAFG GROUP RECORDS Secretary** instead of WSO.

It is my opinion that the following methods will help SIAFG keep updated records:

- Please send Mary S. the contact information for the individual in the District's position who maintains district group record information. (email, address, & phone #). This individual could be the District Representative, Secretary, Group Records Secretary, etc.)
- Send all changes to SIAFG Group Records, Mary S. The group information could be any of the following: group name, meeting address, meeting time, current mailing address, group representative, or group contact and group email or e-mail of person willing to download SIAFG minutes and News-O-Grams.

#### Reminder DO NOT send it to WSO.

- About a month before the Area 16 Assembly I will e-mail the current district information on SIAFG records to the District Representatives so they can proof the information. I would like them to send me corrections.
- 4. At the SIAFG Area Assembly and World Service Committee meetings, updated group information will be given to the District Representatives asking them to check the accuracy of SIAFG' group records. Any errors will be corrected and I will update WSO records.
- Districts Representatives not at the meeting will receive by e-mailed or US mail their districts group information. They are requested to notify the SIAFG Group Records Secretary with changes or that all information is current.

I also request that the **District Representatives include an announcement at their District meeting** about the change in Group Records processing.

If anyone has a suggestion of a better method of doing this, please contact me.


