#### \*\*Delegate's Dialogue: Lyri. M

#### I know of two items from last year's World Service Conference that will likely be discussed again this year:

- 1. Text changes to Concept 11 in the Service Manual including charging the Finance Committee to "set literature pricing in a way that adequately supports the needs of the service structure."
- 2. Discussion of changing our current policy on memorial contributions to include contributions from non-members on behalf of a deceased Al-Anon member. The Conference has been wrestling with this issue in some form since 1962. In 1984 it was decided that accepting money from nonmembers was a violation of Tradition 7. In 2011 the Policy Committee suggested changing the policy to allow contributions by family members of deceased Al-Anon members citing Tradition 5. The WSO gets about a dozen requests year for contributions by nonmembers.

If you or any members of your groups have any guidance on these topics, I would be very grateful if you would share them with me.

The Policy section of the Service Manual (pages 79-125) is currently being reviewed for revision by the Policy Committee. I encourage anyone interested in the policies that shape our fellowship to review this section. You can send suggestions for modifications to me or directly to the Policy Committee c/o the World Service Office.

I was reminded again that I need to look at my attitude and change myself. The poor communication is my responsibility too. I'm critical of him, not remembering that he is sick due to the effects of alcoholism too. I don't say what I mean because of fear of fights or trouble. Not letting my husband know what I think and feel is dishonest. I need to say what I really mean. What do my actions and attitude communicate? How do I release my anger constructively and not hold on to resentments? I liked the 5 guides to communication: Discuss, don't attack, keep the voice low and pleasant, stick to the subject, listen to his or her complaints, and don't make demands. Lastly, am I courteous to my husband or other loved ones in my family? I'm more courteous to others than those that I live with. Again, I have an opportunity to grow in love and service to others. Will you join me?
