COORDINATORS REPORTS

Alateen Coordinator - Becky R.

This fall Alateen has been fairly busy in a very good way. In September I traveled to Pinkneyville, IL for a lovely evening training current and potential AMIAS for their district. We had about 8 individuals at the training for 90 minutes and we had a great discussion.

New Meetings:

I'm very excited that we have 2 meetings started up this fall. Bloomington Normal Alateen started on September 8. We have 2 AMIAS certified and 5 more AMIAS in the certification process. Each week we seem to have 8-10 teens all in the 14-17 age range and they are getting into very good discussions and learning well from each other.

I am also excited to announce that the Springfield area has worked to organize an Alateen meeting. They have about 4 teens consistently traveling to Peoria for their Alateen meeting so they are working to start their own. I've been informed they have about 3 Al-Anon members in the Certification process and they are also trying to start a new Al-Anon meeting at the same time.

Finally, I presented a 50 minutes workshop at the Illinois State Al-Anon Convention. It was primarily background information on Alateen as well as sharing from current AMIAS on ideas, challenges and functions of their Alateen groups. It was a very well attended workshop and we had a very good mix of Southern Illinois and Northern Illinois AMIAS with lots of ideas shared.

She read a quote found in the World Series Archives, "Our founders worked hard, not for themselves, but for those who will join us in the future. The fruit of their labors is not merely a few pages of policies; it's who and what we have become in Al-Anon." From Loretta L., Chairperson of the Regional Trustee Committee, 1975 World Service Conference, page seven.

Also, an article was shared about the history of the daily reader, "One Day At A Time" which was written by on woman, Alice B., Chairman (age 72) of the Literature Committee. She was a self-taught writer. Everyday for one year in 1967, she would sit in a cubby hole with an old typewriter. She just wrote whatever inspired her. It was published in 1968 and went on to sell millions of copies and be translated into several languages.

A folder of the Master Index of Archive Material of each box was displayed for everyone to view. Fern mentioned that a dark circle represents a person or group who has donated material to the So II. Area Archives.

What is Alateen (Al-Anon)?

Alateen, a part of Al-Anon Family Groups, is a fellowship of young people (mostly teenagers) whose lives have been affected by someone else's drinking (or drug use) whether they are in your life using or not. By attending Alateen, teenagers meet other teenagers with similar situations and share their experiences to find solutions to difficult circumstances. Alateen is not a religious program and there are no fees or dues to belong to it.

Al-Anon is for adults and is a mutual support program for people whose lives have been affected by someone else's drinking (or substance abuse). By sharing common experiences and applying the Al-Anon principles, families and friends of alcoholics can bring positive changes to their individual situations, whether or not the alcoholic admits the existence of a drinking problem or seeks help.
